- SSC Training: Role of SSC and Title 1
 - Kristen Bonser reviewed the role of the School Site Council.
- Analysis of Academic Performance Data
 - Kristen Bonser reviewed the Santee School District CAASPP Data
 Presentation as presented by the Director of Assessment. The data included 2023 PRIDE Academy ELA and Math CAASPP data for grades 3-8, and statewide dashboard predictions for the Santee School District. Site Council discussed the achievement of student groups (ML and SWD).
- Review/revision and input into the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA).
 - Ouncil members were presented with materials and data to examine the proposed SPSA goals, strategies/actions, and Title 1 expenditures listed in the proposed 2023-2024 SPSA. Council members split into small groups and completed a feedback form after discussing with peers.
- Budget Update: Budget as in agenda presented.
 - Kristen Bonser explained that the Title 1 deficit was due to the 2022-2023 Promethean Board installation that was not completed prior to 2022-23 deadline. Although the Promethean Boards were purchased and delivered before the end of the year, the Boards were not installed until August. In addition, the Social Worker's salary increased in August due to a significant increase in verified experience. This salary increase was not anticipated or budgeted when the Social Worker was approved by the SSC in the Spring of 2023.
