Certificated Personnel BP 4117.4

DISMISSAL OF CERTIFICATED NON-MANAGEMENT EMPLOYEES

Certificated non-management employees may be dismissed from the service of the district for just cause or because of lay-off of personnel as authorized by the Education Code. Employees so affected will be afforded all due process rights as specified by the Education Code and Government Code

Permanent certificated employees may be dismissed for violation of any of the causes for dismissal as specified in the Education Code, using the procedures prescribed therein.

Probationary certificated employees may be dismissed (not rehired for the ensuing year) at the end of a school year for cause only, using the procedures specified in the Education Code.

Both probationary and permanent certificated employees may be laid off due to a reduction in average daily attendance or reduction or discontinuance of a particular service, using procedures specified in the Education Code. Under these circumstances, care shall be taken that personnel records of such employees show the lay-off was made without prejudice against the employees.
