INTRAMURAL COMPETITION

It is the belief of the Governing Board that competitive sports activities can have positive effects on children's physical and social growth. It is desired that such programs be made available to those students who are able to participate and desirous of doing so.

Each district school is unique, having its own program needs, objectives, organizational designs and capabilities for conducting sports activities. Therefore it is the goal of this procedure to allow enough flexibility for each school to develop a sports program around the specific needs of its students.

The following procedure has been established:

- 1. Each school has the responsibility of designing and implementing its own intramural sports program.
- 2. All intramural sports activities must be approved by the school principal.
- 3. All requests for bus transportation for the purpose of intramural sports activities must be submitted, by the principal, to the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services.
- 4. All athletic activities must comply with Title IX.
- 5. Sports activities must not conflict with or jeopardize the school's academic program.
- 6. A district prepared permission slip must be filled out by the student to be put on file in the principal's office. This will cover, for the year, permission to travel and participate in all sports.
- 7. In case of accidents it will be necessary for each participant to have, in force, a student insurance policy which is presently being offered by the district. According to the district's insurance broker, the policy covers any activities in which student's may engage.
- 8. The principal or vice principal of the receiving school shall be on campus at any scheduled intramural competition.
